<sup>2</sup> Post-diploma programs: These programs require completion of post-secondary coursework and/or post-secondary credentials prior to admission - they are not direct-entry programs. <sup>3</sup> Bachelor of Social Work requires a Social Work diploma or completion of 60 university-level credits, including 3-credits of university-level English, 6-credits of university-level coursework from anthropology, political science, psychology or sociology, and SOWK 240: Introduction to Social Work and Social Welfare (or equivalent) with a minimum grade of C-.

<sup>4</sup> Bachelor of Design does not require students to have a portfolio when applying.

<sup>5</sup> Admission is competitive where the number of qualified applicants exceeds the number of seats available. Competitive programs may have earlier deadlines, higher admission averages or additional admission criteria such as auditions or writing samples.

\*\*To be eligible: applicants must have a minimum of 30 post-secondary credits, including a post-secondary English course with a minimum grade of C+.

\*\*\*Travel and Tourism is a 2-year program compressed into 13 months.



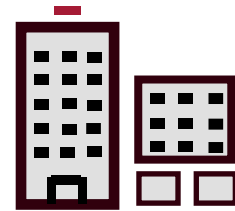

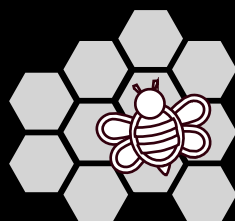

## STEPS TO APPLY

1. Submit an application through [ApplyAlberta.ca](https://www.applyalberta.ca).
2. You will receive a myMacEwan.ca email address. Please log in to the myMacEwan Portal. From this point forward, all communication must be from this address.
3. Submit electronic documents through myStudentSystem within the myMacEwan Portal by August 1 for Fall intakes and December 1 for Winter intakes:
  - a. Login to myMacEwan.ca and click on myStudentSystem
  - b. Click on the "My Documents" tile
  - c. Choose the document type and upload all educational documents and certified translations **separately**:
    - ELP test results (IELTS, TOEFL, etc.)
    - High school transcripts
    - Post-secondary transcripts (university or college, if applicable)
    - Document translations
    - Passport photo page (name verification)
4. Please check program specific requirements and upload any additional items as needed, such as First Aid training or police information checks. Also make arrangements for auditions and portfolio submissions. Upload all electronic documents early to allow for quicker decision times. Refer to the program website for submission instructions.
5. Applications will not be evaluated until all supporting documents are received. Processing time is calculated from date all required documents are received.
6. Once you have received your offer through MyStudentSystem, you must accept the offer and pay the deposit, using Flywire, before the indicated deadline.
7. All final official documents must be submitted directly to the university by respective issuing authority by August 1 for fall intake or December 1 for winter intake. All documents uploaded by an applicant may be used in consideration of an admission decision but are considered unofficial.

## Tuition and Fees

- » Range includes estimated fees and textbooks for one academic year.
- » Bachelor Degree/Diploma: \$25,000 - \$27,000 CAD
- » Specialized Programs: \$28,000 - \$30,000 CAD (Acupuncture, Bachelor of Design, Bachelor of Science in Nursing, Psychiatric Nursing)
- » Foundation Program: \$14,500 - \$16,000 CAD
- » English as an Additional Language (14 weeks): \$6,000 CAD
- » Cost of living is in addition to your estimated tuition and fees. MacEwan's on-campus residence offers competitive pricing and no commute!

## ENGLISH LANGUAGE PROFICIENCY (ELP)

### BACHELOR DEGREES, DIPLOMAS AND CERTIFICATES

IELTS - Minimum overall band score of 6.5 and a minimum score of 5.5 in each component.

TOEFL - 86 iBT (internet-based) and a minimum score of 21 on all 4 sections of Reading/Listening/Speaking/Writing.

Duolingo - Minimum score of 115.

### BACHELOR OF SCIENCE IN NURSING

IELTS - Minimum overall band score of 6.5 and a minimum score of 5.5 in Reading and Writing, 6.0 in Listening and 7.0 in Speaking.

TOEFL - 86 iBT (internet-based) and a minimum score of 21 in Reading and Writing, 23 in Listening and 26 in Speaking.

### PSYCHIATRIC NURSING

IELTS - Minimum overall band score of 7.0 and a minimum score of 6.5 in Reading, 7.0 in Writing, 7.0 in Speaking and 7.5 in Listening.

TOEFL - 98 iBT (internet-based) and a minimum score of 21 in Reading, 27 in Writing, 27 in Listening and 26 in Speaking.

## PREPARATORY PROGRAMS

### ENGLISH AS AN ADDITIONAL LANGUAGE (EAL)

Develop your English language skills in preparation for university studies. Apply directly through [MacEwan.ca/EAL](https://www.macewan.ca/EAL).

Admission requirements: minimum overall IELTS score of 4.0 (with no skill below 3.5), or Duolingo score of 55, or equivalent.

### FOUNDATION PROGRAM INTERNATIONAL

This program offers a combination of EAL, high school and even some university-level courses. You will also take Foundations 101, which teaches you the important research, writing, presentation and academic skills necessary for success in a Canadian university. Apply through ApplyAlberta.

Admission requirements: minimum overall IELTS score of 5.5 with no skill under 4.5, or Duolingo score of 85, or equivalent.
