Step into the spotlight this summer with an immersive journey into the world of musical theatre at MacEwan University.

This immersive summer program for international high school students introduces the foundations of artistic expression through professional musical theatre training. Modeled after MacEwan University's renowned post-secondary Musical Theatre performance program, one of the premier training grounds in Western Canada, participants learn how performers 'think': how to break down a script, master vocal technique and use movement to propel a story.

Performance serves as the practical doorway to the arts industry, providing students with the essential tools to analyze songs and make informed acting choices. While aligned with the same industry standards that define MacEwan's professional programming, the program is not just about memorizing lines; it is about building durable skills: confidence, discipline, and collaborative problem-solving. The program concludes in a final performance showcase, giving students a clearer view of future pathways in the global performing arts industry.



PROGRAM OVERVIEW

- A summer school program for young learners in **grade 10 or higher**.
- One to three weeks of musical theatre training, including dedicated sessions in **Dance/Movement, Voice** and **Acting**.
- Classes hosted by **industry professionals, recent graduates and advanced students** at a Canadian higher education institution located in Edmonton, Alberta.
- **Certificate of Attendance** upon completion and final project showcase.
- **No experience needed:** A welcoming environment designed for newcomers to build language skills and creative talent simultaneously.

**Study tours can last anywhere from 1-3 weeks, but are not required to last the full 3 weeks.*

Upon completion, students will leave with a stronger foundation for future Theatre studies, with the following outcomes:
