3. Students minoring in Philosophy are not required to take junior-level PHIL courses as part of their degree, though they are encouraged to do so. Students are required to research and meet the prerequisites for every senior-level PHIL course they take as part of their degree.
4. Additional philosophy credits can be placed in options. Bachelor of Arts students can take up to 60 credits in any one discipline.
