### Important Planning Notes

1. POLS courses can be used toward the Social Sciences breadth requirement of a Bachelor of Arts degree.
2. POLS courses can be used toward the Social Sciences or Arts core requirement of a Bachelor of Science degree.
3. The POLS 214/215 requirement can also be met using POLS 210 (6CR). The POLS 224/225 requirement can also be met using POLS 220 (6CR). The POLS 264/265 requirement can also be met using POLS 260 (6CR). POLS 210, POLS 220 and POLS 260 were offered at MacEwan prior to the 2011/12 academic year.
4. Students with credit in POLS 264/265 cannot receive credit in POLS 263.
5. Additional political science credits can be placed in options. Bachelor of Arts students can take up to 60 credits in any one discipline.
