Item IV Dean's Report

- The ad for the decanal search is online
- The FA Collective Agreement has been ratified. Joint Committee for the Management of the Agreement (JCMA) will begin meeting soon (FA: Holly Newell, Alissa Overend, and Jasmine French; Board: Ed Lorkovic, Lynn Wells, and Jeremy Wilhelm). Negotiations on the next agreement should start up in the new year
- 35 new faculty positions were approved across Academic Affairs. 20 now and another 15 in the Winter. FAS will have 9 Searches total
- Budget: Will know more when the provincial budget is released Oct 24, not
 much to report at this time. Administrative units to be reviewed, if a small
 cut is required, the University is positioned well. Tuition freeze will likely be
 lifted but the Acting President does not believe a tuition hike should or could
 match cuts. Temporary Out of Scope and MSA hiring freeze was
 implemented and the Joint Benefits Committee made a request for
 additional funding which was declined
- We have a total of 6 Extension of Probation, 2 Tenure, 16 Promotion to Associate Professor, and 4 Promotion to Professor files for the Tenure and Promotion Committees (TPC) this year
- ISP is still on hold, but Mission and Values are being brought to the Board in December
- Code of Conduct Guide is available soon and online training will be available which is recommended. If in doubt, email Ed. For example, missing class to attend a conference is not a conflict of commitment
- IT Security Training is mandatory on an annual basis

- Phishing scams continue, do not respond to emails from Senior administrators from non-MacEwan email accounts
- Library renovations are starting in May 2020. Items will be removed based on several factors, including condition, age, disciplinary needs, relevance to the curriculum, and past use. Librarians will consult with departments. Work between now and Feb 2020. Discarded items to be donated as much as possible. If you have questions, contact your Librarian or the Dean of Libraries.
