5.0 Patterns of Student Appeals – Cheryl Pollard & Vince Salyers

Cheryl sought feedback on what the patterns of appeals mean and what strategies can be used for mitigating the contributing factors being observed with appeals within the Faculty. An in-depth discussion took place on the different appeal levels, how decisions are made and who is involved in appeal meetings. It was emphasized that appeals are handled on a case-by-case basis. The university presently has no set guidelines or provisions for recognizing extenuating circumstances so institutional work is needed on the policy. At the Faculty level, guiding principles are being developed. Some of the key next steps include ensuring that:

- the NPET is completed and administered consistently, and eliminating gaps that may exist.
- faculty know how to write and implement learning plans.
- procedures and resources are available for faculty who identify students at risk.

The Level Facilitators will play an important guiding role and the need for additional supports will be looked at.

6.0 Creation of Indigenous Advisory Council at MacEwan – Margaret Milner

Margaret was a member of the institutional Indigenous Initiatives working group for the last 1.5 years, however, it was recently dissolved due to the formation of the new institutional Indigenous Advisory Council. The council had their first meeting on November 27. They will focus on implementing the TRC calls to action. The composition of members includes faculty, staff, students, elders and community representatives.

The new Faculty of Nursing Indigenous Initiatives working group is being co-chaired by Peter Vermeulen and Paula Culling. The group will be finalizing Terms of Reference to bring to the next Faculty Council meeting. They are also seeking an elder to join the group.

7.0 Information Items

7.1 IT Management Committee Update – Holly Symonds-Brown

Changes to the BlackBoard online grading platform will be implemented on December 22. Blackboard will be down on that date. The changes are expected to be minimal and will not require a rollout.

7.2 International & Global Health Initiatives Working Group Update – Vince Salyers & Liz Burgess-Pinto

The Faculty International Global Health Initiatives working group is looking at ways to engage faculty in exploring and participating in international and global opportunities and ways to identify available resources. The group has developed guidelines and a process for people to follow which will be finalized at their next meeting.

The HLST 400 promotional video for Ukraine was presented and it was noted that so far 17 students have applied to the Ukraine study abroad course planned for May 2018. Collaborative work is on-going with faculty at Ternopil State Medical University. The HLST 400 delivery to the Dominican Republic is being planned for June 2018.
