ENGLISH LANGUAGE PROFICIENCY (ELP)

Bachelor degrees, diplomas and certificates

IELTS - minimum overall band score of 6.5 and a minimum score of 5.5 in each component.

TOEFL - 86 iBT (internet-based) and a minimum score of 21 on all 4 sections of Reading/Listening/Speaking/Writing.

Duolingo - Minimum score of 115.

Bachelor of Psychiatric Nursing

IELTS - Minimum overall band score of 6.5 and a minimum score of 5.5 in Reading, 5.5 in Writing, 7.0 in Speaking and 6.0 in Listening.

TOEFL - 86 iBT (internet-based) and a minimum score of 21 in Reading, 21 in Writing, 23 in Listening and 26 in Speaking.

Foundation Program International

This program offers a combination of EAL, high school and even some university-level courses. You will also take Foundations 101, which teaches you the important research, writing, presentation and academic skills necessary for success in a Canadian university. Apply through [ApplyAlberta](https://macewan.ca/ApplyAlberta).

Admission requirements: minimum overall IELTS score of 5.5 with no skill under 4.5, or Duolingo score of 85, or equivalent.

To be considered for early admission, a complete list of all grade 11 and grade 12 subjects (completed, in-progress and planned) must be presented on your application for admission along with any additional “other” admission requirements. Applications will be evaluated based on final grades in grade 11 and/or grade 12 subjects (or equivalent).

1. Diploma exit option after successful completion of the first two years of the program.
2. Post-diploma programs: These programs require completion of post-secondary coursework and/or post-secondary credentials prior to admission - they are not direct entry programs. Information on admission requirements to these programs can be found by visiting [MacEwan.ca/Programs](#).
3. Bachelor of Social Work requires a Social Work diploma or completion of 60 university-level credits, including 3-credits of university-level English, 6-credits of university-level coursework from anthropology, political science, psychology or sociology, and SOWK 240: Introduction to Social Work and Social Welfare (or equivalent) with a minimum grade of C-.
4. Admission is competitive where the number of qualified applicants exceeds the number of seats available. Competitive programs may have earlier deadlines, higher admission averages or additional admission criteria such as auditions or writing samples.
5. Travel and Tourism is a 2-year program compressed into 13 months.

STEPS TO APPLY

1. Choose your program(s)

Browse the A–Z program list and pick one or two options in case your first choice fills up.

2. Check requirements & deadlines

Review academic prerequisites, English proficiency, and any extra criteria (like résumé, portfolio). Note application deadlines by intake.

3. Consult an international recruiter

Book a meeting to ask questions and get guidance on the application path.

4. Submit your application online

Use ApplyAlberta for most programs, or apply directly via MacEwan's site for EAL or certificate programs. Follow all prompts and pay the fee.

5. Upload transcripts & required documents

Submit official academic records, English test results, passport, etc., per your country's document checklist.

6. Accept your offer & complete requirements

After you receive an offer, accept it, pay your deposit, and download your Letter of Acceptance. Then monitor your student portal (“To Do” list) and check your MacEwan Gmail for any updates.
