from where the grain itself can speak features artwork, historical and contemporary, that gives voice to the plant, human and interspecies relationships that persist through and despite agricultural methods. The work of local and international artists featured here personalizes the complex histories, politics and ideologies embedded in industrial wheat farming. Their stories demonstrate the failure of monocultures of the mind to eradicate alternatives they make more difficult to thrive, as in pesticide-resistant weeds or the relentless reproduction of gophers in a field.
