

STEP-BY-STEP GUIDE: HOW TO APPLY FOR OR EXTEND YOUR CO-OP WORK PERMIT¹ WITHIN CANADA²

HOW TO APPLY: Sign in to your [IRCC secure account](#).

WHEN TO APPLY: Apply for the Co-op Work Permit at the same time you apply for a Study Permit or extend a Study Permit.

If you do not need to extend your study permit, apply at least 6 months before your field placement/practicum/co-op.

COST: Free.

PROCESSING TIME: Check the [IRCC Processing time website](#).

APPLICATION FORM: [IMM5710](#) (Change Conditions, Extend My Stay, or Remain in Canada as a Worker Form).

Please note:

- Documents should be issued within 30 days of submitting your application.
- If you are required to provide several documents in one section, you must scan all of them as one PDF document (the size limit is 4 MB).
- Your documents must be in English or French: if not, provide the English or French translation with an affidavit from the translator certifying the document.

Documents which are required for all students:

- Request a Co-op Work Permit (extension) letter from MacEwan International
- Verification of Enrollment
 - Print or download verification of enrolment
 - Log in to myPortal.MacEwan.ca
 - Launch myStudentSystem
 - In the Academic Records tile, click Enrolment Verification
 - Click Term Enrolment Status
 - Click on the magnifying glass icon to select all terms for the range of terms you would like to verify
 - Click Submit
- Passport (a copy of the page with your name, date of birth, passport number, expiry date and a copy of every page that has stamps, visas, markings or signatures from Canada or other countries).
- Study Permit (if you already have one)
- Digital [passport-sized photo](#)

Step 2 Click on “Apply to come to Canada” and on “Visitor visa, study and/or work permit. Then answer the questions to generate a checklist of required application forms and documents.

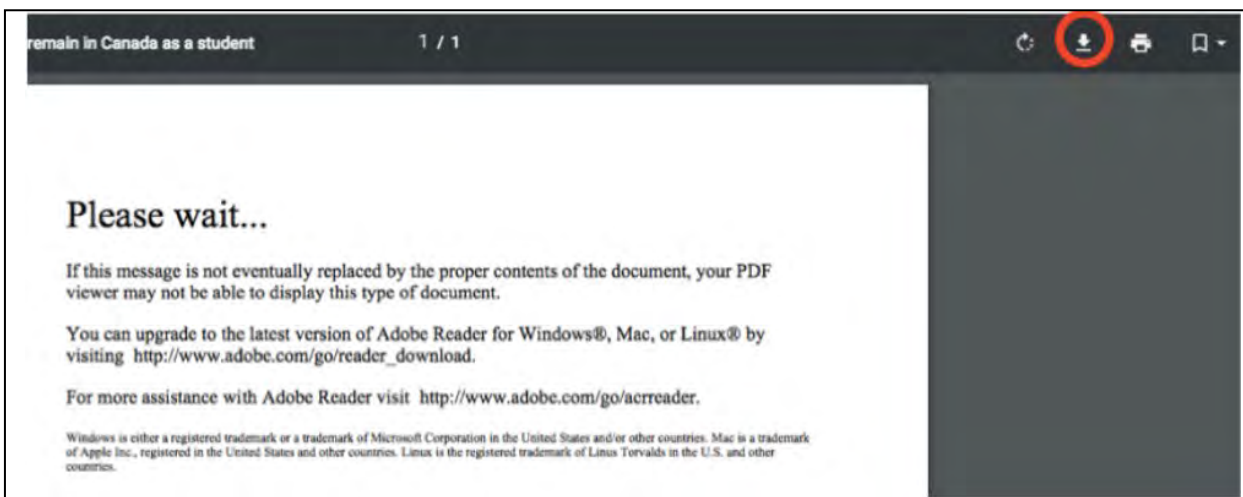

Step 5 Download an application form and save it as a PDF file in the folder on your computer.

Make sure you have AdobeReader (<https://get.adobe.com/reader/>) installed on your computer. Click on the “Application to Change Conditions, Extend my Stay or remain in Canada as a Worker (IMM5710) form. You will see a note “Opens a new window” and a small watch/cursor will appear. Please wait, the form is being downloaded. If you receive a message “Please wait” when you are downloading a form:

- Click on the download arrow at the top right to save the file onto your computer.
- If you do not see the arrow, move your cursor to the top of the screen and it will appear.
- Go to the folder where you saved this form and right click the mouse to open it with Adobe Reader.

Step 7 Validate your application form IMM5710 and upload it.

Step 8 Upload your application documents.

Make sure you merge all the pages of each required document into one PDF document and upload it.

Step 9 Pay the applicable fees and submit your application.

Once you submit your application you will see a “Congratulations!” notice on the page. After that you will receive an “acknowledgement of receipt” email into your IRCC account.

After you apply:

You must have a Co-op Work Permit if your co-op, field placement or practicum is integral to your program of study. You must have a valid Co-op Work Permit to start your practicum. However, if you apply for a Co-op Work Permit and do not receive it by the time your practicum starts, you will need to book an appointment with an international student specialist at MacEwan International to discuss a possibility of starting your co-op, field placement or practicum while waiting for a decision on your application from IRCC. A Co-op Work Permit will be issued for the same length of time as your study permit and allows you to work full-time. Your permit can only be used for work required for your program.
