

STEP-BY-STEP GUIDE: HOW TO APPLY FOR A TEMPORARY RESIDENT VISA (TRV)¹ FROM WITHIN CANADA²

How to apply	Sign in to your IRCC secure account
When to apply	Apply immediately after you have extended your study or work permits or at least three months before your planned travels
Cost	\$100 CAD
Processing time	Check the IRCC Processing time website
Application form	IMM5257(Temporary Resident Visa Made Outside of Canada form)

Gather your required documents:

Please note:

- documents should be issued within 30 days of submitting your application
- if you are required to provide several documents in one section, you must scan all of them as one PDF document (the size limit is 4 MB)
- your documents must be in English or French, if not, provide the English or French translation with an affidavit from the translator certifying the document

Documents which are required for all students:

- Recent educational transcript
 - If you are a current student requesting a transcript for an undergraduate program:
 - Log in to myPortal.MacEwan.ca.
 - Launch myStudentSystem.
 - Go to the Academic Records tile.
 - Click "Request Official Transcript".
 - Select: Immediate Processing, Degree Confer Date or Grade Posting.
 - Select "Send Electronically to MyCreds"
 - Click Submit
 - You will receive notification to your MacEwan Mailbox once your document is available in MyCreds. This may take up to 2 business days.
 - a. In your MyCreds account, click on "Documents" to see your transcript.
 - b. Click on "Download PDF" to download your transcript for your application.

- If you are a current student requesting a non-credit transcript for a non-credit program completed through the School of Continuing Education, please request a transcript [online](#).
- Canadian study permit or work permit
- Verification of enrollment
 - If you are in an **undergraduate credit program of study, please download and print verification of enrollment or credential verification documents** via myStudentSystem.
 - If you are **enrolled in an SCE Professional Development non-credit program of study**, please **request a verification of enrollment** by completing the Enrolment verification letter [request form](#).
 - Log in to myPortal.MacEwan.ca.
 - Launch myStudentSystem.
 - In the Academic Records tile, click **Enrolment Verification**.
 - Click Term **Enrolment** Status.
 - Click on the magnifying glass icon to select term or range of terms you would like to **verify**.
 - Click Submit.
- Proof of means of financial support (an official bank statement, a letter from your parents stating that they will financially support you, etc.)
- Passport (a copy of the page with your name, date of birth, passport number, expiry date and a copy of every page that has stamps, visas, markings or signatures from Canada or other countries).
 - Your TRV will not be issued past your study permit (or work permit) expiry date. **Extend your study permit and passport if they expire soon.**
- Digital [passport-sized photo](#)

Additional documents you might need:

- Medical Exam
- Family Information Form (IMM5707)
- Biometrics
- Client Information Letter (a letter of explanation where you list all additional information you need an immigration officer to know about you)

STEP 1

Create or sign in with your GCKey or Sign-in Partner account on the [IRCC website](#).

STEP 2

Click on “Apply to come to Canada” and on “Visitor visa, study and/or work permit. Then answer the questions to generate a checklist of required application forms and documents.



STEP 5**Download an application form and save it as a PDF file in the folder on your computer.**

Make sure you have AdobeReader (<https://get.adobe.com/reader/>) installed on your computer. Click on the “Application for Visitor Visa (Temporary Resident Visa) Made Outside of Canada (IMM5257) form. You will see a note “Opens a new window” and a small watch/cursor will appear. Please wait, the form is being downloaded. If you receive a message “Please wait” when you are downloading a form:

- Click on the download arrow at the top right to save the file onto your computer
- If you do not see the arrow, move your cursor to the top of the screen and it will appear
- Go to the folder where you saved this form and right click the mouse to open it with Adobe Reader



STEP 6
Fill out your IMM5257 application form.

STEP 7

Validate your application form IMM5257 and upload it.

STEP 8

Upload your application documents.

Make sure you merge all the pages of each required document into one PDF document and upload it.

STEP 9 Pay the applicable fees and submit your application.

Once you submit your application you will see a “Congratulations!” notice on the page. After that you will receive an “acknowledgement of receipt” email into your IRCC account.

AFTER YOU APPLY

When the decision is made on your TRV application, you will receive an email from IRCC with the instructions on how to mail your passport.

1. Purchase two Canada Post Xpresspost prepaid 24 x 32 cm Xpresspost-National envelopes at any Canada Post location. (e.g., MacEwan University, 10700 104th Avenue, Edmonton, AB, T5J 2P2).
2. Put one envelope with your address inside the other so that the IRCC can return your passport securely.
