MacEwan University celebrates Pride Week with the theme Queer Joy

Edmonton - For the first time since 2020, Pride Week will be held on campus at MacEwan with a list of events that includes workshops, hangouts and drag shows.

Running from March 6 to 10, this year's theme is *Queer Joy*—a radical act of resistance and a way to build community and resilience.

"With *Queer Joy* as a theme for Pride Week 2023, our events all seek to explore and revel in that joy,"says Jessica Scalzo, the program coordinator at MacEwan's Centre for Sexual and Gender Diversity (CSGD). "Joyous experiences of queerness allow communities to tell their own stories, rather than merely existing under the traumatic narratives that are imposed by oppressive structures. Claiming your narrative means taking the opportunity to give yourself a past and a future that is yours alone."
