Conservatory of Music

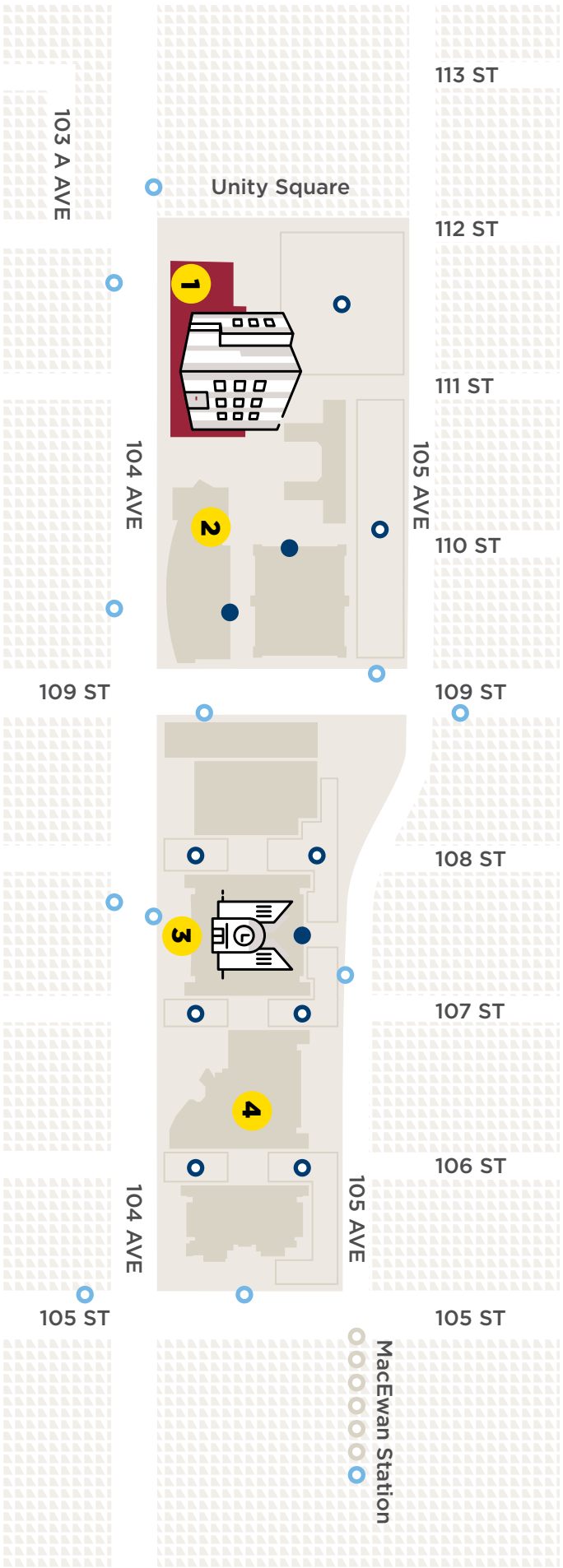
