

School of Social Work Essay and Resume

Applicants to the Bachelor of Social Work or the Social Work Diploma program must complete the following Essay and Resume form. This form requests you provide information on social work practicum/field placements (if applicable), volunteer, and paid work experiences. In the practicum, volunteer, and/or paid work experience(s), you must indicate a **minimum of 70 hours** of human or social service experience. Although only a minimum of 70 hours is required, you should indicate additional practicum, volunteer, and/or paid work experience(s) relevant to human and social services. The form also asks you to respond to seven essay questions related to the profession of social work.

Both, **Part 1 – Resume** and **Part 2 – Essay Questions**, must be completed for your application to be evaluated. This information will be assessed by faculty from the School of Social Work as part of the application process. Space provided for each question/component is limited to 350 words.

Admission to MacEwan's Social Work programs is competitive. Please answer the questions below as completely as possible.
