## **PICKLEBALL RULES**

Intramural Pickleball will, for the most part, follow the official Pickleball Rules as outlined by IFP <u>(2021</u> <u>Edition</u>). The following rule modifications have been adopted based on the needs of MacEwan University Recreation's Pickleball league.

## POLICY

- 1. All players must play under our Code of Conduct. Violation of our Code of Conduct will result in disciplinary action.
- 2. All participants must show identification prior to each game.
- 3. Playing an ineligible participant will result in a Default.
- 4. Teams may consist of any gender

5. If a team does not show for their game, they will Default. If a team gives proper notification of their impending missed game, they will Forfeit.

- 6. A doubles game consists of 2 players per team. Any less than 1 player per team is considered a default.
- 7. If a player is injured during a game they can sub in with an individual of any gender. If an injury results in the team not meeting the participant requirements, they will forfeit.
- 8. In the case of a team having 1 participant, that team shall play shorthanded 1 vs 2. The team that is at full strength may also choose to match 1 vs 1.
- 9. All footwear must be clean and have non-marking soles. Gym strip is required to play.
- 10. Recreation will provide pickleball racquets. Participants may bring their own racquet if they wish.

## SCORING

1. Teams will play rally point, best 2 out of 3 sets or 60 minutes of elapsed time (whichever comes first).

2. All sets go to 21 points.

3. Teams must win each set by 2 points. Games will at 23 points

5. If time runs out prior to the 3rd set's completion, during the regular season, the game will be recorded as a tie.

6. In the playoffs if there is a tie in the 3rd set, and time is up, the next point shall be considered a sudden death point.

7. The Default / Forfeit score is 2-0 (21-0, 21-0)

RULES

- 1. No timeouts are permitted during games.
- 2. If there is time remaining after one team has won 2 sets, both teams are encouraged to continue playing for fun until the end of their scheduled time.
- 3. All games are self-officiated and self score-kept. Teams are responsible for enforcing the rules.

- 4. If a call is disputed, replay the point.
- 5. Each team is required to report their score (for each set) to Recreation Event Staff at the completion of each of their games.
- 6. The court will be the outer badminton lines (both length and width wise).
