

# **VOLLEYBALL RULES**

Volleyball will follow the official rules outlined by <u>FIVB (2017-2020 Edition)</u>. The following exceptions have been implemented to suit the specific needs of all MacEwan University Recreation Volleyball leagues.

## **POLICY**

- 1. All players must play under our Code of Conduct. Violation of our Code of Conduct will result in disciplinary action.
- 2. All participants must show identification prior to each game.
- 3. Playing an ineligible participant will result in a Default.
- 4. Teams may consist of any gender and matching gender opponents is not required.
- 5. If a team does not show for their game, they will Default. If a player gives proper notification of their impending missed game, they will Forfeit.
- 6. This game consists of 6 players on the court per team.
- 7. Each team must have a minimum of 4 participants on the court at all times; any less is considered a default.
- 8. If a player is injured during a game they can sub in with an individual of any gender. If an injury results in a player not being able to continue that player will forfeit their game.
- 9. Teams will play 1 game per day. Games will be scheduled in 50 minute timeslots.
- 10. All footwear must be clean and have non-marking soles. Gym strip is required to play.

### SCORING

- 1. Teams will play rally point, best 2 out of 3 sets or 50 minutes of elapsed time (whichever comes first).
- 2. The first 2 sets will go to 25 points and the third set (if required) to 15 points.
- 3. Teams must win by 2 points. Games will be capped at 27 for the first 2 sets and 17 for the 3rd set (when applicable).
- 4. In the case of a regular season tie (there is no time left to start a 3<sup>rd</sup> set or complete another point), a tie may occur.
- 5. In the case of a playoff tie in the 3<sup>rd</sup> set (with no time left), the following point will be considered a sudden-death point.
- 6. The Default / Forfeit score is 3-0 (25-0, 25-0, 15-0).

### **RULES**

- 1. No timeouts are permitted during games.
- 2. The net height shall be set with 4 exposed notches above the peg.
- 7. If there is time remaining after one team has won 3 sets, both teams are encouraged to continue playing for fun until the end of their scheduled time.
- 8. All games are self-officiated and self score-kept. Teams are responsible for enforcing the rules.
- 9. If a call is disputed, replay the point.
- 10. Each team is required to report their score (for each set) to Recreation Event Staff at the completion of each of their game.
