

New Non-Residential Grants for Ukrainian Scholars

The Ukrainian Resource and Development Centre (URDC)'s initiative to support Ukrainian scholars.

Non-Residential Grants from URDC

Recognizing the need for urgent support of Ukraine's intellectual community in the face of Russia's war of aggression, URDC will offer non-residential grants for scholars in Ukraine. The project will support scholars based in Ukraine as they continue their academic work in times of war.

Eligibility

The grants are open to Ukrainian scholars in URDC's partner institutions. URDC is offering five grants in the amount of \$2,000 CAD each. Applicants who have previously received this grant are not eligible to reapply until five years have passed from the date of their grant receipt.

Expectations

The scholar will:

- Receive a grant in the amount of \$2,000 to continue academic work at home university in Ukraine;
- Devote their time to collaborative endeavours with the corresponding faculty at MacEwan:
 - 1- Engage in research activity with a MacEwan scholar;
 - 2- Conduct two online lectures for MacEwan and the wider community (one introductory lecture and one lecture on the research topic).
- Academic activities related to the grant will take place between March and October 2025.

Application Process

The application materials are submitted via email and should include:

- Brief project description (max. 1 page)
- CV
- Contact details for one reference.

The language for the application is English.

Application deadline: December 15, 2024.

Decisions regarding applications will be communicated to applicants on February 3, 2025.

The selection committee is not required to publicly justify its decisions, nor to give individual feedback to applicants. Please note that by submitting an application, you consent to URDC sharing your application materials with experts for purposes of evaluation.
