Background

Recognizing the need for urgent support of Ukraine's intellectual community in the face of Russia's war of aggression, URDC will offer non-residential grants for Ukrainian scholars from partner universities in Ukraine. The project will support scholars based in Ukraine as they continue their academic work in the times of war.

Conditions

The grants are open annually to Ukrainian scholars in one of MacEwan University's partner institutions.

We accept applications for six grants in the following disciplines:

- Sociology
- Political Science
- Communications
- Nursing
- English
- Jazz music

The application materials are submitted via email and should include:

- Brief project description (max. 1 page)
- CV
- Contact details for one reference.

The language for the application is English.
